1-9 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-10 AN ACT

1-11 relating to limiting use of money in the Texas Enterprise Fund to  
1-12 recipients that provide health benefit plans.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Section 481.078, Government Code, is amended by  
1-15 adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:

1-16 (k) A grant of money from the fund may not be made to a  
1-17 recipient unless the recipient, as one of the performance targets  
1-18 in the agreement, commits to providing a health benefit plan to the  
1-19 recipient's full-time employees who are employed in a facility or  
1-20 activity financed by the grant.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
