1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the payment of benefits to certain retirees of the
1-11 Teacher Retirement System of Texas who return to work.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 824.602, Government Code, is amended by
1-14 adding Subsections (p) and (q) to read as follows:

1-15 (p) The exception provided by Subsection (a)(3) continues
1-16 to apply to work performed by a retiree in June of a school year if:

1-17 (1) the work the retiree agreed to complete under the
1-18 contract or work agreement cannot be completed by May 31; and

1-19 (2) the retiree does not work beyond June 15 of that
1-20 year.

1-21 (q) Time spent by a retiree attending professional
1-22 development classes or activities is not considered work for
1-23 purposes of Subsection (a)(3).

1-24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-25 to a retiree of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas who resumes
1-26 employment with a Texas public educational institution on or after
1-27 the effective date of this Act.

1-28 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
