5	SECTION 1. Section 521.141, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) A driver education school may administer an examination
8	to a student of that school under Section 521.1655 before the
9	student applies for an instruction permit or driver's license.
10	SECTION 2. Section 521.1655, Transportation Code, is
11	amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
12	read as follows:
13	(a) A driver education school licensed under <u>Chapter 1001,</u>
14	Education Code, [the Texas Driver and Traffic Safety Education Act
15	(Article 4413(29c), Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)] may administer
16	to a student of that school the [$ extsf{vision_r}$] highway sign[$ extsf{-}$] and
17	traffic law parts of the examination required by Section 521.161 <u>if</u>
18	the student:
19	(1) is 15 years of age or older, but under 18 years of
20	age, and has completed and passed six hours of classroom
21	instruction of a driver education course approved under Chapter
22	1001, Education Code; or
23	(2) is 18 years of age or older and has completed and

Section 1001.101, Education Code, is amended to 7 read as follows: COURSE CURRICULUM Sec. 1001.101. DRIVER EDUCATION 8 AND 9 TEXTBOOKS. (a) The commissioner by rule shall establish the 10 curriculum and designate the textbooks to be used in: 11 (1) a driver education course for minors and adults; 12 and 13 (2) a traffic law classroom driver education course 14 for adults. (b) A driver education course under Subsection (a)(2) must: 15 16 (1) be a six-hour course; and 17 (2) include instruction in the following: (A) driver's <u>license requirements;</u> 18 (B) vehicle inspection and registration; 19 20 (C) financial responsibility; 21 (D) highway signs that regulate, warn, or direct 22 traffic; and (E) the traffic laws of this state, including the 23 laws and penalties concerning driving while intoxicated or driving 24 25 under the influence of alcohol. (c) An approved driving safety course does not qualify as a 26 27 course under Subsection (a)(2).

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an application for the issuance of a driver's license filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for the issuance of a driver's license filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of the filing, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
