- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.141, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A driver education school may administer an examination
- 8 to a student of that school under Section 521.1655 before the
- 9 student applies for an instruction permit or driver's license.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 521.1655, Transportation Code, is
- amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and
- 12 (c) to read as follows:
- 13 (a) A driver education school licensed under Chapter 1001,
- 14 Education Code, [the Texas Driver and Traffic Safety Education Act
- 15 (Article 4413(29c), Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) may administer
- 16 to a student of that school the  $[vision_{\tau}]$  highway sign $[\tau]$  and
- 17 traffic law parts of the examination required by Section 521.161 if
- 18 the student:
- 19 (1) is 15 years of age or older, but under 18 years of
- 20 age, and has completed and passed six hours of classroom
- 21 <u>instruction of a driver education course approved under Chapter</u>
- 22 1001, Education Code; or
- 23 (2) is 18 years of age or older and has completed and
- 24 passed a six-hour traffic law classroom driver education course

approved under Chapter 1001, Education Code. 1 2 (a-1) A person conducting a driver education course approved under Section 521.205 may administer the highway sign and 3 4 traffic law parts of the examination required by Section 521.161 5 if: 6 (1) the student is 15 years of age or older, but under 7 18 years of age, and has completed and passed the course; and (2) the course is equivalent to a course under 8 9 Subsection (a)(1). (c) A driver education school may electronically administer 10 an examination under this section provided that the school produces 11 an electronic record of the examination and retains the record for 12 the period required by the commissioner of education. 13 SECTION 3. Section 1001.101, Education Code, is amended to 14 15 read as follows: Sec. 1001.101. DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE CURRICULUM 16 AND 17 TEXTBOOKS. (a) The commissioner by rule shall establish the curriculum and designate the textbooks to be used in: 18 19 (1) a driver education course for minors and adults; 20 and 21 (2) a traffic law classroom driver education course 22 for adults. (b) A driver education course under Subsection (a)(2) must: 23 24 (1) be a six-hour course; and 25 (2) include instruction in the following: 26 (A) driver's license requirements;
