4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 521.006, Transportation Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	Sec. 521.006. ADVERTISING IN DRIVER'S HANDBOOK AND DRIVER'S
8	LICENSE MAILINGS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the
9	department may sell advertising <u>for inclusion</u> in <u>:</u>
10	(1) any driver's handbook that the department
11	publishes; and
12	(2) any mailing the department makes in connection
13	with a driver's license.
14	(b) The department shall deposit the proceeds from the
15	advertising to the credit of the driver's <u>license administration</u>
16	[handbook] advertising account. The driver's <u>license</u>
17	<u>administration</u> [handbook] advertising account is an account in the
18	general revenue fund that may be appropriated only for the purpose
19	of administration of this chapter.
20	(c) The department may not include in the driver's handbook
21	<u>or a driver's license mailing</u> advertising for an alcoholic beverage
22	or a product promoting alcoholic beverages.
23	SECTION 2. This Act does not abolish the driver's handbook

23 SECTION 2. This Act does not abolish the driver's handbook 24 advertising account, but renames the account as the driver's

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1 license administration advertising account.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
