

AN ACT

relating to the penalty for certain violations of county traffic regulations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 251.161, Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

(b) An ~~[Except as provided by Subsections (c) and (d), an]~~ offense under this section is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200 ~~[\$50]~~.

(c) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor may be prosecuted under this section or the other law ~~[If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this section that the person has previously been convicted one time of the offense, the offense is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200]~~.

SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Section 251.161, Transportation Code, is repealed.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
