5	SECTION 1. Sections 348.006(a) and (c), Finance Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The principal balance under a retail installment
8	contract is computed by:
9	(1) adding:
10	(A) the cash price of the motor vehicle;
11	(B) each amount included in the retail
12	installment contract for an itemized charge; and
13	(C) subject to Subsection (c), a documentary fee
14	for services rendered for or on behalf of the retail buyer in
15	preparing, handling, and processing documents and complying with
16	federal and state statutes, rules, and regulations, including those
17	regarding privacy, security safeguards, and reporting
18	requirements, relating to the motor vehicle and to the closing of
19	the retail installment transaction; and
20	(2) subtracting from the results under Subdivision (1)
21	the amount of the retail buyer's down payment in money, goods, or

(c) For a documentary fee to be included in the principal

- 1 (1) the retail seller must charge the documentary fee
- 2 to cash buyers and credit buyers;
- 3 (2) the documentary fee may not exceed \$100 [\$50] for a
- 4 motor vehicle retail installment contract or a reasonable amount
- 5 agreed to by the retail seller and retail buyer for a heavy
- 6 commercial vehicle retail installment contract; and
- 7 (3) the buyer's order and the retail installment
- 8 contract must include:
- 9 (A) a statement of the amount of the documentary
- 10 fee; and
- 11 (B) in reasonable proximity to the place in each
- 12 where the amount of the documentary fee is disclosed, the following
- 13 notice in type that is bold-faced, capitalized, underlined, or
- 14 otherwise conspicuously set out from surrounding written material:
- "A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT AN OFFICIAL FEE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE
- 16 IS NOT REQUIRED BY LAW, BUT MAY BE CHARGED TO BUYERS FOR HANDLING
- 17 DOCUMENTS AND PERFORMING SERVICES RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF A
- 18 SALE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE MAY NOT EXCEED \$100 [\$50] FOR A MOTOR
- 19 VEHICLE CONTRACT OR A REASONABLE AMOUNT AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES FOR
- 20 A HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLE CONTRACT. THIS NOTICE IS REQUIRED BY
- 21 LAW."
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to a retail installment contract entered into on or after the
- 24 effective date of this Act. A retail installment contract entered
- into before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 26 effect when the retail installment contract is entered into, and
- the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
