- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 25.0951, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If a student fails to attend school without excuse on 10
- 8 or more days or parts of days within a six-month period in the same
- 9 school year, a school district shall within 10 [seven] school days
- 10 of the student's last absence:
- 11 (1) file a complaint against the student or the
- 12 student's parent or both in a county, justice, or municipal court
- 13 for an offense under Section 25.093 or 25.094, as appropriate, or
- 14 refer the student to a juvenile court in a county with a population
- of less than 100,000 for conduct that violates Section 25.094; or
- 16 (2) refer the student to a juvenile court for conduct
- indicating a need for supervision under Section 51.03(b)(2), Family
- 18 Code.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
