4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 305, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 305.0242 to read as follows:
- Sec. 305.0242. ADDITIONAL RESTRICTION ON EXPENDITURES FOR

 LEGISLATORS. A person registered under Section 305.005 or a person

 on the registrant's behalf and with the registrant's consent or

 ratification may not make an expenditure for food or beverages

 provided as a meal to a member of the legislature or an expenditure

 for an alcoholic beverage provided to a member of the legislature

 unless:
- 14 <u>(1) the expenditure may otherwise be made under this</u> 15 chapter; and
- 16 (2) the food or beverage is provided at a reception or
 17 similar event at which 30 or more persons are present.
- SECTION 2. Section 305.031, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 21 (a) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally 22 or knowingly violates a provision of this chapter other than 23 Section 305.022, 305.0242, or 305.028. An offense under this 24 subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.

- 1 (c) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
 2 or knowingly violates Section 305.0242. An offense under this
 3 subsection is a Class C misdemeanor. If conduct constituting an
 4 offense under this subsection also constitutes an offense under
 5 another law, the actor may be prosecuted under this subsection or
 6 the other law.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
