S.B. No. 1233

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the general property deposit paid by a student to a 3 public institution of higher education. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 54.502(a), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 (a) An institution of higher education may collect a 7 reasonable deposit in an amount not to exceed \$100 from each student 8 to insure the institution against any losses, damages, and breakage 9 for which the student is responsible and to cover any other amounts 10 owed by the student to the institution [in libraries and 11 12 laboratories]. The institution shall return to the student the deposit, less any such amounts owed to the institution by the 13 14 student. The deposit must be returned within a reasonable period after the date of the student's withdrawal or graduation from the 15 institution, not to exceed 180 days, that provides the institution 16 with sufficient time to identify all amounts owed and to determine 17 that the student does not intend to enroll at the institution in the 18 semester or summer session immediately following the student's 19 withdrawal or graduation or, if the student withdraws or graduates 20 21 in the spring semester, in the next fall semester [The deposit 22 shall be returned on the withdrawal or graduation of a student, less 23 an amount necessary to cover any loss, damage, or breakage caused by 24 the student].

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
