- 2 relating to local regulation of distance requirements for

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 109.33, Alcoholic
- 6 Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 109.33. SALES NEAR SCHOOL, CHURCH, [OR] HOSPITAL,
- 8 HOMELESS SHELTER, OR TRANSITIONAL HOUSING CENTER.
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 109.33(a) and (b), Alcoholic Beverage
- 10 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The commissioners court of a county may enact
- 12 regulations applicable in areas in the county outside an
- 13 incorporated city or town, and the governing board of an
- 14 incorporated city or town may enact regulations applicable in the
- 15 city or town, prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages by a
- dealer whose place of business is within:
- 17 (1) 300 feet of a church, public or private school,
- 18 [or] public hospital, homeless shelter, or transitiional housing
- 19 center;
- 20 (2) 1,000 feet of a public school, if the
- 21 commissioners court or the governing body receives a request from
- the board of trustees of a school district under Section 38.007,
- 23 Education Code; or
- 24 (3) 1,000 feet of a private school if the

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- commissioners court or the governing body receives a request from the governing body of the private school.
- 3 (b) The measurement of the distance between the place of 4 business where alcoholic beverages are sold and the church, [or] 5 public hospital, homeless shelter, or transitional housing center
- 6 shall be along the property lines of the street fronts and from
- 7 front door to front door, and in direct line across intersections.
- 8 The measurement of the distance between the place of business where
- 9 alcoholic beverages are sold and the public or private school shall
- 10 be:
- 11 (1) in a direct line from the property line of the
- 12 public or private school to the property line of the place of
- 13 business, and in a direct line across intersections; or
- 14 (2) if the permit or license holder is located on or
- 15 above the fifth story of a multistory building, in a direct line
- 16 from the property line of the public or private school to the
- 17 property line of the place of business, in a direct line across
- intersections, and vertically up the building at the property line
- 19 to the base of the floor on which the permit or license holder is
- 20 located.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
