- 6 SECTION 1. Section 521.126, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (d), (e), and (g), a
- 9 person commits an offense if the person:
- 10 (1) accesses or uses electronically readable
- 11 information derived from a driver's license, commercial driver's
- 12 license, or personal identification certificate without the
- 13 <u>consent of the license or certificate holder</u>; or
- 14 (2) compiles or maintains a database of electronically
- 15 readable information derived from driver's licenses, commercial
- driver's licenses, or personal identification certificates without
- 17 the consent of each license or certificate holder whose information
- 18 <u>is compiled or maintained</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 20 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 21 Act. For the purposes of this section, an offense is committed
- 22 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 23 occurs before that date.
- (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this

- 1 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
