12	carrier is organized or incorporated; and

15	more frequent basis] as the department considers necessary. At a
16	minimum, the department shall examine a carrier not less frequently
17	than once every five years.
18	(b) [If the commissioner determines that the financial
19	strength of a carrier justifies less frequent examinations than
20	those required under Subsection (a)(2), the department may conduct
21	the examination at intervals not less frequent than every five
22	years.] The commissioner shall adopt rules governing the <u>frequency</u>
23	of examinations of carriers that have been organized or
24	incorporated for less than five years [determination under this

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1 subsection of whether the financial strength of a carrier justifies less frequent examinations]. 2 SECTION 2. Section 1305.251, Insurance Code, is amended by 3 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 4 5 (c) A network shall pay a fee to the department, in an amount set by the commissioner and in accordance with rules adopted by the 6 7 commissioner, for the expenses of an examination conducted under this section or Section 1305.252 that: 8 (1) are incurred by the commissioner or under the 9 commissioner's authority; and 10 (2) are directly attributable to that examination, 11 including the actual salaries and expenses of the examiners 12 directly attributable to that examination, as determined under 13 rules adopted by the commissioner. 14 (d) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited to 15 16 the credit of the Texas Department of Insurance operating account. 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
