7	(8) "Hotel" means the premises of an establishment:
8	(A) where, in consideration of payment,
9	travelers are furnished food and lodging;
10	(B) in which are located:
11	<u>(i)</u> at least 10 adequately furnished
12	completely separate rooms with adequate facilities so comfortably
13	disposed that persons usually apply for and receive overnight
14	accommodations in the establishment, either in the course of usual
15	and regular travel or as a residence; <u>or</u>
16	(ii) at least five rooms described by
17	Subparagraph (i) if the building being used as a hotel is a historic
18	structure as defined by Section 442.001, Government Code; and
19	(C) which operates a regular dining room
20	constantly frequented by customers each day.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
