| 8 | (d) "Nonresident" must appear on the face of a [nonresident |
| 9 | commercial driver's license issued under this section. |
| 10 | (e) The department may issue a temporary nonresident |

| 13 | otherwise meets the requirements for a nonresident commercial |

- 6 SECTION 2 Soction 522 021 Transportation Code
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 522.021, Transportation Code, is amended 7 by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-1) If the application is for a nonresident commercial</u> 9 driver's license and the applicant is a resident of a foreign
- 10 jurisdiction that does not meet the testing and licensing standards
- 11 <u>established by 49 C.F.R. Part 383, the applicant must present:</u>
- 12 (1) a social security card issued to the applicant;
- 13 and
- 14 (2) each of the following:
- 15 (A) a passport issued to the applicant by the
- 16 country of which the applicant is a resident;
- 17 (B) a Temporary Worker visa; and
- 18 (C) a Form I-94 Arrival/Departure record or a
- 19 successor document.
- SECTION 3. Section 522.029, Transportation Code, is amended
- 21 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (j) to read as
- 22 follows:
- 23 (a) The fee for a commercial driver's license or commercial
- 24 driver learner's permit issued by the department is \$60, except as
- provided by Subsections (f), [and] (h), and (j).
- 26 (j) The fee for a nonresident commercial driver's license is
- 27 \$120. The fee for a temporary nonresident commercial driver's

- 2 SECTION 4. Section 522.051, Transportation Code, is amended
- 3 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (f) and Sections
- 6 522.013(e) and [Section] 522.033, an original commercial driver's
- 7 license or commercial driver learner's permit expires five years
- 8 after the applicant's next birthday.
- 9 <u>(f) Except as provided by Section 522.013, a nonresident</u>
- 10 commercial driver's license other than a temporary nonresident
- commercial driver's license under Section 522.013(e) expires on the
- 12 <u>earlier of:</u>
- 13 (1) the expiration date of the visa presented under
- 14 <u>Section 522.021(a-1)(2)(B); or</u>
- 15 (2) the expiration date of the Form I-94
- 16 Arrival/Departure record, or a successor document, presented under
- 17 <u>Section 522.021(a-1)(2)(C).</u>
- SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 19 a nonresident commercial driver's license for which an original or
- 20 renewal application is filed on or after the effective date of this
- 21 Act.
- 22 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
