1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the compounding of a drug or device by a pharmacist.  
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 554, Occupations Code, is  
1-13 amended by adding Section 554.056 to read as follows:  
1-14 Sec. 554.056. RULEMAKING; ADDITION OF FLAVORING TO  
1-15 COMMERCIAL PRODUCT. The board may adopt rules governing the  
1-16 procedures for a pharmacist, as part of compounding, to add  
1-17 flavoring to a commercial product at the request of a patient or a  
1-18 patient's agent.  
1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
