- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1701.352, Occupations Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsections (g) and (g-1) to read as follows:

- 16 (g-1) Not later than September 1, 2012, a peace officer who
 17 holds a license issued by the commission before September 1, 2007,

- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 96, Education Code, is 22 amended by adding Section 96.642 to read as follows:

- 1 Management Institute of Texas shall design and establish a basic
- 2 education and training program and an advanced education and

- 6 (b) Not later than January 1, 2008, the institute shall
- 7 begin offering the programs established under this section to peace
