Call the national human trafficking hotline: 14 1-888-373-7888. You may remain anonymous. (b) The sign must be at least 8-1/2 inches high and 11 inches 15 wide and displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the 16 public and employees of the permit or license holder. The English 17 notice must cover approximately two-thirds of the sign, and the 18

Spanish notice must cover approximately one-third of the sign.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
