S.B. No. 1287

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to providing certain notices to be posted on the premises  
3 of alcoholic beverage retailers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 104, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended  
6 by adding Section 104.07 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 104.07. POSTING OF CERTAIN NOTICES REQUIRED. (a) The  
8 holder of a permit or license under Chapter 25, 26, 28, 32, 69, or  
9 71, other than the holder of a food and beverage certificate, shall  
10 display a sign containing the following notice in English and in  
11 Spanish:

12 WARNING: Obtaining forced labor or services is a crime under  
13 Texas law. Call the national human trafficking hotline:  
14 1-888-373-7888. You may remain anonymous.

15 (b) The sign must be at least 8-1/2 inches high and 11 inches  
16 wide and displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the  
17 public and employees of the permit or license holder. The English  
18 notice must cover approximately two-thirds of the sign, and the  
19 Spanish notice must cover approximately one-third of the sign.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
