1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to providing certain notices to be posted on the premises
1-11 of alcoholic beverage retailers.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Chapter 104, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
1-14 by adding Section 104.07 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 104.07. POSTING OF CERTAIN NOTICES REQUIRED. (a) The
1-16 holder of a permit or license under Chapter 25, 26, 28, 32, 69, or
1-17 71, other than the holder of a food and beverage certificate, shall
1-18 display a sign containing the following notice in English and in
1-19 Spanish:

1-20 WARNING: Obtaining forced labor or services is a crime under
1-21 Texas law. Call the national human trafficking hotline:
1-22 1-888-373-7888. You may remain anonymous.

1-23 (b) The sign must be at least 8-1/2 inches high and 11 inches
1-24 wide and displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the
1-25 public and employees of the permit or license holder. The English
1-26 notice must cover approximately two-thirds of the sign, and the
1-27 Spanish notice must cover approximately one-third of the sign.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
