- 2 relating to the attendance by a quorum of a governmental body at
- 3 certain events under the open meetings law.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subdivision (4), Section 551.001, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (4) "Meeting" means:
- 8 (A) a deliberation between a quorum of a
- 9 governmental body, or between a quorum of a governmental body and
- 10 another person, during which public business or public policy over
- 11 which the governmental body has supervision or control is discussed
- or considered or during which the governmental body takes formal
- 13 action; or
- 14 (B) except as otherwise provided by this
- 15 subdivision, a gathering:
- 16 (i) that is conducted by the governmental
- 17 body or for which the governmental body is responsible;
- 18 (ii) at which a quorum of members of the
- 19 governmental body is present;
- 20 (iii) that has been called by the
- 21 governmental body; and
- (iv) at which the members receive
- 23 information from, give information to, ask questions of, or receive
- 24 questions from any third person, including an employee of the

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- governmental body, about the public business or public policy over
- 2 which the governmental body has supervision or control.
- 3 The term does not include the gathering of a quorum of a
- 4 governmental body at a social function unrelated to the public
- 5 business that is conducted by the body, or the attendance by a
- 6 quorum of a governmental body at a regional, state, or national
- 7 convention or workshop, <u>ceremonial event</u>, or <u>press conference</u>, if
- 8 formal action is not taken and any discussion of public business is
- 9 incidental to the social function, convention, $[\frac{\partial \mathbf{r}}{\partial t}]$ workshop,
- 10 ceremonial event, or press conference.
- 11 The term includes a session of a governmental body.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
