BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 418.073, Government Code, is amended by 1-13 1**-**14 1**-**15 1-16 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 1-17 (c) The purposes for which money in the disaster contingency fund may be used include making funds available to a state or local agency that will use the funds to provide assistance to producers of agricultural products affected by or recovering from a disaster caused by severe drought or wildfire. In this subsection, 1-19 1-20 1-21 "agricultural products" includes: 1-22 (1) horticultural, viticultural, forestry, 1-23 da<u>iry</u>, livestock, poultry, and bee products, including products of exotic livestock as defined by Section 161.001, Agriculture Code; and 1-24 1-25 1-26 (2) any farm or ranch product. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
