The performance of manipulation under anesthesia or needle 9 electromyography constitutes the practice of medicine and may be 10 11 performed only by or under the delegation and supervision of a 12 physician. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 17
