A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to reimbursements made to El Paso County by Culberson and
3	Hudspeth Counties for certain costs.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 43.120, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsections (d) and (f) and adding Subsections (d-1) and
7	(d-2) to read as follows:
8	(d) The commissioners courts of Culberson and Hudspeth
9	counties shall each pay to El Paso County the budgeted prosecution
10	costs [\$100 a month to be expended, on sworn claims of the district
11	attorney approved by the Commissioners Court of El Paso County,
12	for the preparation and conduct of criminal affairs of the district
13	attorney's office, including compensation for assistants and other
14	employees of the district attorney, applicable to their respective
15	county. Each year the district attorney's office shall:
16	(1) prepare a budget and financial statement for the
17	upcoming fiscal year; and
18	(2) file the budget and financial statement with the
19	commissioners courts of Hudspeth and Culberson counties.
20	(d-1) The budget and financial statement required by
21	Subsection (d) must contain:
22	(1) the budgeted prosecution costs for El Paso,
23	Culberson, and Hudspeth counties, with the costs for each county
24	listed separately; and

- 1 (2) any additional information considered appropriate
 2 by the district attorney or required by the commissioners court of
- 3 El Paso, Culberson, or Hudspeth County.

- 4 (d-2) Hudspeth and Culberson counties shall remit
 5 one-fourth of the budgeted prosecution costs applicable to the
 6 respective county to El Paso County not later than the last day of
 7 each fiscal quarter.
 - expended by the district attorney for the preparation and conduct of criminal affairs of the district attorney's office, including funds to compensate assistants and other employees of the district attorney. [The assistants and other employees of the district attorney are compensated by the Commissioners Court of El Paso County.] The Commissioners Court of El Paso County must approve the number of assistants and other employees appointed by the district attorney and the amount of compensation of those employees.
