AN ACT

2 relating to district hearings and citizen suits for illegally 3 drilling or operating a water well. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), and (c), Section 36.119, 6 Water Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) Drilling <u>or operating</u> a well <u>or wells</u> without a required
8 permit or <u>producing groundwater in violation of a district rule</u>
9 <u>adopted under Section 36.116(a)(2)</u> [operating a well at a higher
10 rate of production than the rate approved for the well] is declared
11 to be illegal, wasteful per se, and a nuisance.

12 Except as provided by this section, a landowner or other (b) 13 [A] person who has a right to produce groundwater from land that is 14 [an estate in land] adjacent to the land on which a [the] well or wells are drilled or operated without a required permit or permits 15 or from which groundwater is produced in violation of a district 16 rule adopted under Section 36.116(a)(2) [is located], or who owns 17 18 or otherwise has a right to produce groundwater from land [a part] that lies within one-half mile of the well or wells, may sue the 19 owner of the well or wells in a court of competent jurisdiction to 20 21 restrain or enjoin the illegal drilling, [or] operation, or both. The suit may be brought with or without the joinder of the district. 22 23 (c) Except as provided by this section, the [The] aggrieved

24 party may also sue the owner of the well or wells for damages for

injuries suffered by reason of the illegal operation or production 1 and for other relief to which the party [they] may be entitled. In a 2 suit for damages against the owner of the well or wells, the 3 4 existence [or operation] of a well or wells drilled without a required permit or the operation of a well or wells in violation of 5 6 a district rule adopted under Section 36.116(a)(2) [in violation of 7 the rules of the district] is prima facie evidence of illegal 8 drainage.

9 SECTION 2. Section 36.119, Water Code, as amended by this 10 Act, applies only to a violation occurring on or after the effective 11 date of this Act. Any violation occurring before the effective date 12 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the 13 violation occurred, and that law is continued in effect for that 14 purpose.

15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
