- 2 relating to rental of a vehicle to a member of the armed forces;
- 3 providing a civil penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 35, Business & Commerce
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 35.63 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 35.63. RENTAL OF VEHICLE TO MEMBER OF ARMED FORCES.
- 8 (a) In this section, "vehicle rental company" means a person whose
- 9 primary business is renting private passenger vehicles to the
- 10 public for 30 days or less.
- 11 (b) A vehicle rental company may not refuse to rent a
- 12 private passenger vehicle to a person because of the person's age or
- 13 because the person does not present a credit card or debit card if
- 14 the person presents a valid military identification card indicating
- that the person is a member of the United States armed forces.
- 16 (c) A vehicle rental company that violates this section is
- 17 liable to the state for a civil penalty of not more than \$1,000 for
- 18 <u>each violation</u>. The attorney general or the prosecuting attorney
- in the county in which a violation occurs may bring suit to recover
- 20 <u>the civil penalty imposed under this subsection.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
