1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the filing of a conflicts disclosure statement by a
1-9 vendor or member of a governing body of a port authority or
1-10 navigation district.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter P, Chapter 60, Water Code, is
1-13 repealed.

1-14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-15 on or after the effective date of this Act. A disclosure statement
1-16 required to be made before that date is governed by the law as it
1-17 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
1-18 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
