21	Issuing other document							
22	(no return required) \$1.00 for							
23	first page							
24	\$0.25 for each additional page							
25	SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a cause of action filed							
26	on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action filed							
27	before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in							

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- 1 effect at the time the cause of action was filed, and that law is
- 2 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
