- 8 exceeds  $\frac{$250}{}$  [ $\frac{$20}{}$ ], a dissatisfied party may appeal the final
- 9 judgment to the county court or county court at law.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a cause of action filed
- on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action filed
- 12 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 13 effect at the time the cause of action was filed, and that law is
- 14 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
