5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 88, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 88.503 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 88.503. SPATIAL REFERENCE CENTER. (a) The board may
8	create and operate a spatial reference center at Texas A&M
9	UniversityCorpus Christi for the purpose of:
10	(1) facilitating the federal height modernization
11	project for the state;
12	(2) conducting basic and applied research regarding
13	elevation and geodetic and vertical datums in the state;
14	(3) collecting geodetic data for state mapping and
15	control; and
16	(4) establishing and maintaining an official digital
17	spatial reference system for the state, in coordination with:
18	(A) the United States National Geodetic Survey;
19	(B) the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
20	Administration;
21	(C) the Texas Natural Resources Information
22	System; and
23	(D) the Texas Water Development Board.
24	(b) The board shall adopt rules relating to the operation of

## 1 the spatial reference center.

(c) The spatial reference center may solicit and accept
gifts, grants, and appropriations for the purposes of this section.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
