- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 25.13, Alcoholic
- 7 Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) An applicant or holder of a food and beverage
- 9 certificate shall have food service facilities for the preparation
- 10 and service of multiple entrees. The commission shall adopt rules
- 11 as necessary to assure that the holder of a food and beverage
- 12 certificate maintains food service as the primary business on the
- 13 premises for which a food and beverage certificate has been issued.
- 14 The commission may exempt permittees who are concessionaires in
- 15 public entertainment venues such as sports stadiums and convention
- 16 centers from the requirement that food service be the primary
- 17 business on the premises.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 69.16, Alcoholic
- 19 Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 20 (b) An applicant or holder of a food and beverage
- 21 certificate shall have food service facilities for the preparation
- 22 and service of multiple entrees. The commission shall adopt rules
- 23 as necessary to assure that the holder of a food and beverage
- 24 certificate maintains food service as the primary business on the

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- 1 premises for which a food and beverage certificate has been issued.
- 2 The commission may exempt permittees who are concessionaires in
- 3 public entertainment venues such as sports stadiums and convention
- 4 centers from the requirement that food service be the primary
- 5 <u>business on the premises.</u>
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
