1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to information and training for public school educators in
1-10 the prevention of child abuse.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 38.004, Education Code, is amended by
1-13 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

1-14 (a-1) The agency shall:

1-15 (1) maintain on the agency Internet website a list of
1-16 links to websites that provide information regarding the prevention
1-17 of child abuse; and

1-18 (2) develop and periodically update a training program
1-19 on prevention of child abuse that a school district may use for
1-20 staff development.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
