BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 352.002, Tax Code, is amended by adding

6 Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

- 7 (a-1) In addition to the counties described by Subsection (a), the commissioners court of a county in which an airport 8 essential to the economy of the county is located may by the 9 10 adoption of an order or resolution impose a tax on a person who, under a lease, concession, permit, right of access, license, 11 12 contract, or agreement, pays for the use or possession or for the 13 right to the use or possession of a room that is in a hotel, costs \$2 14 or more each day, and is ordinarily used for sleeping. For the 15 purposes of this subsection, an airport is considered to be essential to the economy of a county only if the airport is a 16
- 17 <u>commercial-service international airport within Class C airspace</u>
- and is located in a county and owned by a municipality each having a
- 19 population of less than 125,000. This subsection does not apply to
- 20 <u>a county described by Subsection (a)(13).</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 352.003, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 22 Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- (h) The tax rate in a county authorized to impose the tax
- under Section 352.002(a-1) may not exceed one percent of the price

- 1 paid for a room in a hotel in the county.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 352.109, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 3 Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 4 (b-1) A county authorized by Section 352.002(a-1) to impose
- 5 a tax under this chapter shall produce an annual report that
- 6 describes the tourism, hotel, and convention activity that is
- 7 attributable to events held at facilities that received funding
- 8 from the tax during the period covered by the report.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
