## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the cancellation of the voter registrations of persons
3	who are not United States citizens.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 62.113, Government Code,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	(b) On the third business day of each month, the clerk shall
8	send a copy of the list of persons excused or disqualified because
9	of citizenship in the previous month to the voter registrar of the
10	county and the secretary of state.
11	SECTION 2. Section 16.0332, Election Code, is amended to
12	read as follows:
13	Sec. 16.0332. CANCELLATION BECAUSE OF CITIZENSHIP STATUS.
14	(a) After the secretary of state receives a list under Section
15	62.113, Government Code, of persons excused or disqualified from
16	jury service because of citizenship status, the secretary of state
17	shall cancel the voter registration of each registered voter whose
18	name appears on the list.
19	(b) After the registrar receives a list under Section
20	62.113, Government Code, of persons excused or disqualified from
21	jury service because of citizenship status, the registrar shall
22	deliver to each registered voter whose name appears on the list $[\frac{1}{4}]$
23	written notice that the person's voter registration has been
24	<u>canceled</u> [ <del>requiring the voter to submit to the registrar proof of</del>

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1	United States citizenship in the form of a certified copy of the
2	voter's birth certificate, United States passport, or certificate
3	of naturalization or any other form prescribed by the secretary of
4	state. The notice shall be delivered by forwardable mail to the
5	mailing address on the voter's registration application and to any
6	new address of the voter known to the registrar].
7	[ <del>(b) If a voter fails to submit to the registrar proof of</del>
8	<del>citizenship on or before the 30th day after the date the notice is</del>
9	mailed, the registrar shall cancel the voter's registration.
10	[ <del>(c) The registrar shall retain a copy of the notice mailed</del>
11	to a voter under this section on file with the voter's registration
12	application. The registrar shall also retain any proof of
13	citizenship received under this section on file with the
14	application.]
15	SECTION 3. Subsection (c), Section 16.036, Election Code,
16	is amended to read as follows:
17	(c) The notice must include:
18	(1) the date of cancellation;
19	(2) the reason for cancellation; and
20	(3) a brief explanation of the voter's right to
21	challenge the cancellation and to appeal the [ <del>registrar's</del> ] decision
22	of the registrar or secretary of state, as applicable.
23	SECTION 4. This Act applies only to a person summoned for
24	jury duty on or after the effective date of this Act. A person
25	summoned for jury duty before the effective date of this Act is
26	governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
27	of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that

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1 purpose.

## 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
