- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 29.018 to read as follows:
- Sec. 29.018. SPECIAL EDUCATION GRANT. (a) From funds

 appropriated for the purposes of this section, federal funds, or

 any other funds available, the commissioner shall make grants

 available to school districts to assist districts in covering the

 cost of educating students with disabilities.
- (b) A school district is eligible to apply for a grant under this section if:
- (1) the district does not receive sufficient funds

 under Section 42.151 for a student with disabilities to pay for the

 services provided to the student; or
- 17 (2) the district does not receive sufficient funds
 18 under Section 42.151 for all students with disabilities in the
 19 district to pay for the services provided to the students.
- 20 (c) A school district that applies for a grant under this
 21 section must provide the commissioner with a report comparing the

- 1 (d) Expenses that may be included by a school district in
