5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 38.021 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.021. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION CONCERNING SCHOOL
8	NURSES. (a) A public school that does not have a full-time school
9	nurse assigned to the campus for more than 30 consecutive
10	instructional days during the same school year shall provide
11	written notice of the absence of a nurse to the parent of or other
12	person standing in parental relation to each student enrolled in
13	the school.
14	(b) The principal of the school shall provide the notice
15	required by Subsection (a) not later than the 30th instructional
16	day after the first day the school does not have a full-time school
17	nurse assigned to the campus.
18	(c) The school shall:
19	(1) make a good faith effort to ensure that the notice
20	required by this section is provided in a bilingual form to any
21	parent or other person standing in parental relation whose primary
22	language is not English; and
23	(2) retain a copy of any notice provided under this
24	section.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
