5	SECTION 1. Section 551.045, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
7	(e) For purposes of Subsection (b)(2), the sudden
8	relocation of a large number of residents from the area of a
9	declared disaster to a governmental body's jurisdiction is
10	considered a reasonably unforeseeable situation for a reasonable
11	period immediately following the relocation. Notice of an
12	emergency meeting or supplemental notice of an emergency item added
13	to the agenda of a meeting to address a situation described by this
14	subsection must be given to members of the news media as provided by
15	Section 551.047 not later than one hour before the meeting.
16	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
