4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 7.031 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 7.031. STUDY OF BEST PRACTICES FOR DROPOUT PREVENTION.
8	(a) The agency shall:
9	(1) study the best practices of campuses and school
10	districts in this state and other states regarding dropout

- 11 prevention programs; and
- 12 (2) prepare a report regarding the findings of the
- 13 study.
- 14 (b) The report under Subsection (a) must:
- (1) identify any high-performing and highly efficient
 dropout prevention programs;
- (2) identify the dropout prevention programs under
- 18 Subdivision (1) that have the most potential for success in this
- 19 state; and
- 20 (3) recommend legislation or other actions necessary
- 21 to implement a dropout prevention program identified under
- 22 Subdivision (2).
- (c) Not later than December 1, 2008, the agency shall
- 24 deliver the report produced under Subsection (a) to the governor,

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- 1 the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
- 2 representatives, and the presiding officers of the standing
- 3 committees of each house of the legislature with primary
- 4 jurisdiction over public education.
- 5 (d) This section expires January 1, 2009.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
