A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- relating to the transfer of certain state property from the Texas 2 Department of Criminal Justice to Burnet County. 3
- Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. (a) Not later than November 1, 2007, the Texas 5 6 Department of Criminal Justice shall transfer to Burnet County the
- 7 real property described by Subsection (d) of this section.
- (b) Burnet County shall use the property transferred under 8
- this Act only for a purpose that benefits the public interest of the 9
- state. If Burnet County no longer uses the property for a purpose 10
- that benefits the public interest of the state, ownership of the 11
- 12 property automatically reverts to the Texas Department of Criminal
- 13 Justice.

- 14 The Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall transfer
- the property by an appropriate instrument of transfer. The 15
- instrument of transfer must: 16
- include a provision that: 17 (1)
- requires Burnet County to use the property 18
- 19 for a purpose that benefits the public interest of the state; and
- 20 (B) indicates that ownership of the property
- automatically reverts to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice 21
- 22 if Burnet County no longer uses the property for a purpose that
- 23 benefits the public interest of the state; and
- 24 (2) describe the property to be transferred by metes

- 1 and bounds.
- 2 (d) The real property to which Subsection (a) of this
- 3 section refers is described as follows:
- 4 Field notes of a 75.00 acre tract of land out of the 300.00 acre
- 5 Texas Department of Criminal Justice Tract recorded in Cabinet 2,
- 6 Slide 49-C of the Burnet County Plat Records also being out of the
- 7 300.00 acres conveyed to Texas Department of Criminal Justice in
- 8 Volume 608, Page 19 of the Official Public Records of Burnet County,
- 9 Texas. The basis of bearing for this survey is the recorded plat of
- 10 said Texas Department of Criminal Justice Tract.
- 11 Beginning at a 1/2" steel stake found in the North right-of-way line
- 12 of County Road 100 (Scenic Oaks Drive as shown on the plat of Oak
- 13 Vista Subdivision recorded in Cabinet 1, Slides 183 C & D and 184 A &
- 14 B of the Burnet County Plat Records, Burnet County, Texas) and the
- 15 South line of that certain Tract No. 68 of said Oak Vista
- 16 Subdivision for the Southwest corner of said 178.686 acre tract,
- 17 the Southwest corner of said Texas Department of Criminal Justice
- 18 Tract and the Southwest corner hereof;
- 19 Thence leaving the North right-of-way line of said County Road and
- the South line of said Tract No. 68 with the West line of said 300.00
- 21 acre tract, the West line of said Texas Department of Criminal
- 22 Justice Tract and the West line hereof North 13°01'53" West, at a
- 23 distance of 3378.75 to a Cedar Fence Post Found in the South
- 24 right-of-way line of Oak Vista Drive and the North line of Tract No.
- 25 59 of said Oak Vista Subdivision for the Northwest corner of said
- 26 Texas Department of Criminal Justice Tract and the Northwest corner
- 27 hereof;

- 1 Thence with the South right-of-way line of said Oak Vista Drive, the
- 2 North line of said 300.00 acre tract, the North line of said Texas
- 3 Department of Criminal Justice Tract, and the North line hereof
- 4 with (2) calls as follows: North $76^{\circ}51'56"$ East, a distance of
- 5 698.12 feet (698.67) feet to a 1/2" steel stake found for an angle
- 6 point hereof;
- 7 Thence North $76^{\circ}32'08''$ East, a distance of 3378.75 feet to a 1/2''
- 8 steel stake set with plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 for the
- 9 Northeast corner of this 75.00 acre tract.
- 10 Thence along the East line of this 75.00 acre tract South 13°01'53"
- 11 East, a distance of 3380.60 feet to a 1/2" steel stake set with
- 12 plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 in the North right-of-way line of
- 13 said County Road 100 for the Southeast corner hereof, from which a

- 20 for an angle point hereof;
- 21 Thence South $76^{\circ}54'09"$ West, a distance of 280.33 feet to the Place
- 22 of Beginning.

- 7 300.00 acre Texas Department of Criminal Justice Tract and at the
- 8 Southwest corner of a 6.00 acre tract conveyed to Fluorine on Call,
- 9 LTD. recorded in Volume 1034, Page 85 of the Official Public Records
- of Burnet County, Texas having a tie of N 12°59'10" W, 944.99 feet to
- 11 a 1/2" steel stake found at the Northeast corner of said 300.00 acre
- 12 tract.
- 13 Thence along the East line of said 300.00 acre Texas Department of
- 14 Criminal Justice Tract and the west line of a 29.227 acre remnant of
- 15 170.290 acres conveyed to the City of Burnet in Volume 565, Page 126
- of the Official Public Records of Burnet County, Texas also being
- 17 the West end of Ellen Halbert Drive an unrecorded City of Burnet
- 18 street (L1) S13 $^{\circ}$ 00'00"E, 72.69 feet to a 1/2" steel stake set with
- 19 plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 lying on the East line of said
- 20 300.00 acre Texas Department of Criminal Justice Tract and west
- 21 line of said 29.237 acres.
- Thence leaving the East line of said 300.00 acre Texas Department of
- 23 Criminal Justice Tract and along the Southerly line of this 70.00
- 24 foot wide Access Easement with 1/2" steel stakes set with plastic
- 25 cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 with the next eight (8) calls as follows:
- 26 (L2) N87°21'03"W, 470.72 feet to a curve (C2) to the right having a
- 27 radius of 235.00 feet, a delta angle of $74^{\circ}11'12''$, and a chord

- 8 of tangency.
- 9 Thence (L6) S $48^{\circ}30'05''$ E, 257.66 feet to a curve to the left having
- 10 a radius of 165.00 feet, a delta angle of $48^{\circ}48'13''$, and a chord
- 11 bearing and distance of N $79^{\circ}02'05''$ W, 136.33 feet. Thence along
- 12 said curve an arc distance of 140.54 feet to a point of tangency.
- Thence (L9) S $76^{\circ}33'50''$ W, 226.79 feet; (L11) S $76^{\circ}28'46''$ E, 1947.12
- 14 feet to a 1/2" steel stake set with plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S.
- 15 1877 lying on the East line of the above described 75.00 acre tract.
- 16 Thence along the East line of said 75.00 acre tract, N 13 $^{\circ}$ 01'53" E,
- 17 70.00 feet to a 1/2" steel stake set with plastic cap stamped
- 18 R.P.L.S. 1877 lying on the East line of said 75.00 acre tract and
- having a tie of N 13°01'53" W, 461.55' to a 1/2" steel stake set with
- 20 plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 being the Northeast corner of
- 21 said 75.00 acre tract.
- Thence leaving the East line of said 75.00 acre tract and along the
- 23 Northerly line of this 70.00 foot wide Access Easement (L12) N
- 24 76°28'46" E passing a cedar fence post found at an L corner of said
- 25 300.00 acres at 1328.57 feet in all 1946.58 feet to a 60 D nail in a
- 26 cedar fence post found being an angle point on the north line of
- 27 said 300.00 acre tract.

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- 1 Thence along said north line (L8) N $76^{\circ}33'50''$ E, 226.84 feet to a
- 2 1/2" steel stake set with plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 and a
- 3 curve to the right, having a radius of 235.00 feet, a delta angle of
- $49^{\circ}47'52"$, and a chord bearing and distance of S $78^{\circ}32'15"$ E, 197.88
- 5 feet.
- 6 Thence along said curve an arc distance of 204.25 feet to a 1/2"
- 7 steel stake set with plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877.
- 8 Thence (L5) S $48^{\circ}30'05''$ E, 261.08 feet to a 1/2'' steel stake set with
- 9 plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 and a curve (C3) to the right
- 10 having a radius of 235.00 feet, a delta angle of 35°20'13", and a
- 11 chord bearing and distance of S 30°49'58" E, 142.65 feet.
- 12 Thence along said curve an arc distance of 144.94 feet to a 1/2"
- 13 steel stake set with plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877.
- Thence (L7) S $13^{\circ}09'52''$ E, 235.10 feet to a 1/2'' steel stake set with
- 15 plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877 and a curve (C1) to the left
- 16 having a radius of 165.00 feet, a delta angle of $74^{\circ}11'13''$, and a
- 17 chord bearing and distance of S $50^{\circ}15'28''$ E, 199.03 feet.
- 18 Thence along said curve an arc distance of 213.64 to a 1/2" steel
- 19 stake set with plastic cap stamped R.P.L.S. 1877.
- Thence (L3) N $87^{\circ}21'03''$ W, 451.12 for the Point of Beginning.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
