## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to registration statements filed by an insurer that is a

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 823.052, Insurance Code,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	(a) To register as required by Section 823.051, an insurer
8	must file [ <del>with the department</del> ] a registration statement <u>with the</u>
9	<u>department</u> [ <del>and a copy of the charter or articles of incorporation</del>
10	and bylaws of the insurer's holding company, each of the insurer's
11	subsidiaries, and, if the commissioner considers the information
12	necessary, any of the insurer's other affiliates].
13	SECTION 2. Section 823.055, Insurance Code, is amended to
14	read as follows:
15	Sec. 823.055. ANNUAL REGISTRATION STATEMENT; SUMMARY OF
16	MATERIAL CHANGES [AMENDMENTS; CONSOLIDATION OF AMENDMENTS].
17	(a) In this section, "ultimate controlling person" means the
18	person in an insurance holding company system who is not controlled
19	by another person.
20	(b) Not later than the 120th day after the last day of each
21	fiscal year of the ultimate controlling person, each registered
22	insurer in the ultimate controlling person's insurance holding

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1	registration statement current].
2	(c) An insurer required to file an annual registration
3	statement shall also furnish a summary of material changes from the
4	prior year's annual registration statement as specified by [ <del>Not</del>
5	later than the 120th day after the last day of each calendar year
6	ending in a five or a zero, each registered insurer in the ultimate
7	controlling person's insurance holding company system shall file a
8	completely restated registration statement that consolidates all
9	amendments to the most recently filed registration statement into
10	that statement and contains all changes occurring since the last
11	amendment was filed. The consolidated registration statement must
12	be in the format that] the commissioner [adopts] by rule.
13	[ <del>(d) A registered insurer is not required to file an</del>
14	amendment under Subsection (b) in the year in which the insurer
15	files a consolidated registration statement under Subsection (c).

16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
