- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subpart H, Part 2, Chapter XIII, Texas Probate
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 665D to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 665D. COMPENSATION OF ATTORNEYS SERVING AS GUARDIANS.
- 8 (a) An attorney who represents a ward in a guardianship matter
- 9 while serving as the ward's guardian is not entitled to
- 10 compensation or to receive reimbursement for those services from
- 11 the ward's estate or other funds available for that purpose unless
- 12 the attorney files with the court a detailed description of the type
- 13 of services performed for which the attorney is requesting
- 14 compensation or reimbursement.
- 15 (b) An attorney described by Subsection (a) of this section
- is not entitled to attorney's fees for fiduciary services that are
- 17 not legal services.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 665D, Texas Probate Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies only to fees for services performed on or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act. Fees for services performed before
- 21 the effective date are covered by the law in effect when the
- 22 services were performed, and the former law is continued in effect
- 23 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
