## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the registration and operation of certain off-highway
3	vehicles.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subdivision (1), Section 502.001,
6	Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	(1) "All-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that
8	is not a golf cart and is:
9	(A) equipped with a saddle or bench for the use
10	of <u>:</u>
11	<u>(i)</u> the rider; <u>and</u>
12	(ii) a passenger, if the motor vehicle is
13	designed by the manufacturer to transport a passenger;
14	(B) designed to propel itself with three or more
15	tires in contact with the ground;
16	(C) designed by the manufacturer for off-highway
17	use [ <del>by the operator only</del> ]; and
18	(D) not designed by the manufacturer primarily
19	for farming or lawn care.
20	SECTION 2. Section 29.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	Sec. 29.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "off-highway
23	vehicle" means:
24	(1) an all-terrain vehicle, as defined by Section

1 663.001, Transportation Code; 2 (2) an off-highway motorcycle; and 3 (3) any other motorized vehicle used for off-highway 4 recreation on: 5 (A) public land over which the department has authority or on land purchased or leased by the department; or 6 7 (B) land acquired or developed under a grant made under Section 29.008 or any other grant program operated or 8 administered by the department [four-wheel drive vehicle not 9 10 registered to be driven on a highway]. 11 SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 29.003, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows: 12 Except as provided by Section 29.004, a person may not 13 (a) operate an off-highway vehicle on public land over which the 14 department has authority, on land purchased or leased by the 15 16 department, [a trail or in a recreational area established or maintained by the department under this chapter, on other public 17 land,] or on land purchased or developed under a grant made under 18 Section 29.008 or any other grant program operated or administered 19 20 by the department on which off-highway vehicle recreation is legal without having obtained and properly mounted an off-highway vehicle 21 decal. 22 SECTION 4. Section 29.004, Parks and Wildlife Code, 23 is amended to read as follows: 24 25 Sec. 29.004. EXEMPTIONS. Section 29.003 does not apply to a 26 person that is: acting on behalf of the United States, any state, 27 (1)

1 or a political subdivision of the United States or any state;

(2) participating in a search and rescue operation
under the authority or direction of a search and rescue or law
enforcement agency; [<del>or</del>]

5 (3) <u>a nonresident and the off-highway vehicle is</u> 6 <u>registered under the laws of the owner's home state; or</u>

(4) exempt under a rule adopted by the commission.

8 SECTION 5. Subsection (a), Section 29.005, Parks and 9 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 (a) The department shall issue an off-highway vehicle decal 11 [to any person whose off-highway vehicle is registered under 12 Section 502.006, Transportation Code,] on the payment of the fee 13 under Section 29.003(b).

SECTION 6. Chapter 29, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended by adding Section 29.011 to read as follows:

Sec. 29.011. SAFETY APPAREL REQUIRED. A person may not operate, ride, or be carried on an off-highway vehicle on public property unless the person wears:

19 (1) a safety helmet that complies with United States
 20 Department of Transportation standards; and

## (2) eye protection.

SECTION 7. Subsections (c) and (d), Section 502.006, and Sections 502.169, 502.205, and 502.406, Transportation Code, are repealed.

25 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
