## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to eligibility of certain persons for an alcoholic 3 beverage license or permit. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 11.44, Alcoholic Beverage Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 11.44. PREMISES INELIGIBLE FOR PERMIT OR LICENSE. (a) 7 If an order of suspension against a permit or license is pending or 8 unexpired, or if the commission has initiated action to cancel or 9 suspend a permit or license, no permit or license may be issued for 10 11 or transferred to the same licensed premises. 12 (b) The commission or administrator shall refuse to issue 13 for a period of three years a permit or license for any location to 14 an applicant who submitted a prior application that expired or was voluntarily surrendered before the hearing on the application was 15 held on a protest involving allegations of prostitution, a 16 shooting, stabbing, or other violent act, or an offense involving 17 18 drugs. The three-year period commences on the date the prior application expired or was voluntarily surrendered. 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 20 21 to an application for a license or permit submitted on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of the date on which a 22

23 previous application expired or surrendered. An application
24 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the

S.B. No. 1564 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Act}}$  , and 1 that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 2 3

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
