4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 562, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 562.057 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 562.057. COMMERCIAL USE STUDY. (a) The board shall
8	study how prescription information records containing
9	patient-identifiable and practitioner-identifiable information
10	are licensed, transferred, used, or sold by pharmacy benefits
11	managers, insurance companies, electronic transmission
12	intermediaries, pharmacies, or other similar entities for the
13	purpose of advertising, marketing, or promoting pharmaceutical
14	products.
15	(b) Not later than August 1, 2008, the board shall submit to
16	the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
17	representatives, and the appropriate standing committees of the
18	legislature a report regarding the results of the study conducted
19	under Subsection (a), together with any recommendation for
20	legislation.
21	(c) This section expires October 1, 2008.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
