- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.119, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (g) to

- 8 (f) The commission shall adopt rules to ensure that the
- 9 owner or operator of a recycling facility, including a composting
- 10 or mulching facility, has in place:
- 11 (1) sufficient financial assurance conditioned on
- 12 satisfactorily operating and closing the facility and consistent
- 13 with the requirements of Section 361.085 for a solid waste facility
- other than a facility for the disposal of hazardous waste; and
- 15 (2) sufficient financial assurance to cover the
- 16 potential costs necessary to fight and extinguish a fire at the
- facility, as determined by the commission.
- 18 <u>(g) Subsection (f)</u> [This subsection] applies only to an
- 19 owner or operator of a recycling facility:
- 20 (1) at which combustible material is stored outdoors;
- 21 or
- 22 (2) that poses a significant risk to public health and
- 23 safety as determined by the commission.
