- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 2308.264, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) In consultation with local workforce development
- 8 boards, the Texas Workforce Commission by rule shall establish
- 9 contracting guidelines for boards under this section, including
- 10 quidelines designed to:
- 11 (1) ensure that each independent contractor that
- 12 contracts to provide one-stop workforce services under this section
- 13 has sufficient insurance, bonding, and liability coverage for the
- 14 overall financial security of one-stop workforce services funds and
- 15 operations;
- 16 (2) prevent potential conflicts of interest between
- 17 boards and entities that contract with boards under this section;
- 18 and
- 19 (3) ensure that if a board acts as a fiscal agent for
- 20 an entity that contracts with the board to provide one-stop
- 21 workforce services, the board does not deliver the services or
- 22 determine eligibility for the services[; and]
- [(4) ensure that an entity that contracts with a board
- 24 under this section may use, display, and advertise the entity's

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## 1 name when providing workforce services for the board].

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
