BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 2301, Occupations Code, is 1-13 1-14 1-15 amended by adding Section 2301.361 to read as follows:

Sec. 2301.361. OFFSITE SALES. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a dealer may only sell or offer to sell a motor 1-16 vehicle from an established and permanent place of business: 1-17 (1) that is approved by the division; and 1-18 1-19 1-20 for which a general distinguishing number has been issued. 1-21 A dealer may sell or offer to sell a motor vehicle online through an advertisement on the Internet to a buyer who never personally appears at the dealer's established and permanent place 1-22 1-23 of business.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-24 1-25 1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-27 1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
