Section 52.81(2), Education Code, is amended to 3 read as follows: (2) "Bond" means a general obligation bond issued by 4 the board under former [Article III,] Section  $50b-3[\tau]$  or Sections 5 50b-4, [or] 50b-5, or 50b-6, Article III, [of the] Texas 6 7 Constitution. 8 SECTION 4. Section 52.82(a), Education Code, is amended to 9 read as follows: (a) The board may by resolution authorize the issuance of 10 general obligation bonds in total aggregate amounts not to exceed: 11 \$300 million under former Section 50b-3, Article 12 (1) III, Texas Constitution; 13 \$300 million under Section 50b-4, Article III, 14 (2) 15 Texas Constitution; [and] (3) \$400 million under Section 50b-5, Article III, 16 Texas Constitution; and 17 (4) \$500 million under Section 50b-6, Article III, 18 19 Texas Constitution. SECTION 5. Section 52.87, Education Code, is amended to 20 read as follows: 21 Sec. 52.87. MANDAMUS. The performance of official duties 22 prescribed by this subchapter and by former Section [Article III, 23 24 Sections] 50b-3[7] and Sections 50b-4, [and] 50b-5, and 50b-6, Article III, [of the] Texas Constitution, in reference to the 25 payment of the bonds, may be enforced in a court of competent 26 27 jurisdiction by mandamus or other appropriate proceedings.

1 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect on the date on which the 2 constitutional amendment proposed by the 80th Legislature, Regular 3 Session, 2007, providing for the issuance of \$500 million in 4 general obligation bonds to finance educational loans to students 5 and authorizing bond enhancement agreements with respect to such 6 bonds takes effect. If that amendment is not approved by the 7 voters, this Act has no effect.
