4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 142, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 142.0021 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 142.0021. PERSONAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES MINIMUM
8	TRAINING STANDARDS. (a) The executive commissioner of the Health
9	and Human Services Commission shall adopt rules prescribing minimum
10	training standards for an employee of a person licensed to provide
11	personal assistance services under this chapter.
12	(b) The minimum training standards must require that, not
13	later than the 120th day after the date an employee is initially
14	hired to provide personal assistance services, the employee
15	complete at least 16 hours of training.
16	(c) The minimum training standards must require training in
17	at least the following areas:
18	(1) cultural sensitivity;
19	(2) communication skills;
20	(3) proper lifting and moving techniques;
21	(4) safe cooking techniques; and
22	(5) dementia and Alzheimer-related issues.
23	(d) The Department of Aging and Disability Services shall
24	ensure that a person licensed to provide personal assistance

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1	services under this chapter provides training to the person's
2	employees that complies with the requirements of this section.
3	SECTION 2. Section 142.0021(b), Health and Safety Code, as
4	added by this Act, applies to an employee hired on or after the
5	effective date of the rules adopted in compliance with Section
6	142.0021(a), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
7	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
