- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.051(b), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) If the judgment is against the defendant, the defendant 8 shall pay the judgment immediately. A judgment entered against a 9 defendant must require that if the defendant does not pay the 10 judgment immediately, the defendant must provide the plaintiff with 11 the defendant's:
- 12 (1) street address and mailing address, if different;
- 13 (2) driver's license number or state identification
- 14 number; and

- 15 (3) employer's name and address.
- SECTION 2. Section 28.051(b), Government Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a judgment rendered against a defendant on or after the effective date of this Act. A judgment rendered before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 20 applicable immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 21 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
